

Privacy Statement pursuant to Article 13 of Regulation (EU) 679/2016 - General Data Protection Regulation

We inform you that our Company will be processing the data provide by you only for the purpose of replying to your requests for information. Your personal data will be processed according to methods and procedures - including with the aid of electronic tools - necessary for the exclusive pursuit of the above purpose. The legal basis for the processing consists in the need to fulfil a pre-contractual obligation.

Your data will not be disclosed and may only be known by our staff specifically authorized to process them as Data Processors or Persons in charge thereof and/or by third-party entities to whom UnipolSai entrusts the performance of activities on its own behalf and with whom specific agreements aimed at regulating data processing have been entered into.

Your data will be retained for the time strictly necessary to reply to your requests.

The privacy legislation (Articles 15-22 of the Regulation) guarantees you the right to gain access to any data concerning you at any time and to obtain their rectification and/or make any additions thereto, if inaccurate or incomplete, their erasure, if processed illegally, or the portability of the data provided by you if processed in an automated manner for the contractual services requested by you, within the limits of the provisions of the Regulation (Article 20). The privacy legislation also guarantees you the right to request the restriction of the data processing, if the relevant conditions have been met, and to object to their processing for reasons related to your particular situation.
